## Four Year • More than 20,000 students

Professor Lyn Noble has watched student engagement and retention increase since introducing MyMathLab for homework in her College Algebra course. She credits students' ability to get the practice they need via the learning styles that work best for them as a critical driver of these important student gains.
During the first year of MyMathLab use, withdrawal rates decreased by more than half: from 16 percent before adoption to 7 percent after. Noble also lauds the predictive ability of the program, citing that significantly more students passed the MyMathLab-enabled course if they had a passing quiz average: 83.3 percent of students who earned an $\mathrm{A}, \mathrm{B}$, or C on the quizzes also earned an $\mathrm{A}, \mathrm{B}$, or C in the course.
