

## Specifying Color and Contrast Settings

Some users need higher or a different color scheme or color contrast to see content on pages. For example, you may find it easier to see light text on a dark background, dark text on a light background, or in grayscale.

Operating System	How to Change Your Contrast Scheme
<b>Windows 10</b>	<p>Choose color and contrast scheme from the operating system's Ease of Access settings.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Press Window logo key + U to open Ease of Access settings, then select "High contrast."</li> <li>2. Under Choose a theme, select a high contrast theme from the drop-down menu, and then select "Apply."</li> </ol>
<b>Windows 8 and 8.1</b>	<p>Choose a contrast scheme from the operating system's display settings.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Select "Settings"</li> <li>2. Select "Change PC settings," and then select "Ease of Access."</li> <li>3. Under "High contrast," select the button to turn high contrast on and off.</li> </ol>
<b>Windows 7</b>	<p>Choose a contrast scheme from the operating system's display settings.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. From the Control Panel select "Ease of Access Center."</li> <li>2. Select "Set up High Contrast."</li> <li>3. Select "Choose a High Contrast Theme." <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ For black text on a light background, use High Contrast Black.</li> <li>○ For white text on a dark background, use High Contrast White.</li> <li>○ Or try different contrast schemes until you find the one that helps you most.</li> </ul> </li> </ol> <p>Note that this tool is limited and it will not apply the color scheme to the Player.</p>

Operating System	How to Change Your Contrast Scheme
<b>ZoomText with Windows</b>	<p>Choose from several color and contrast schemes using the software product ZoomText.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Select "Color" from the menu</li> <li>2. From the "Scheme" menu choose a combination that works for you</li> <li>3. For lighter color text on a dark background select Invert Brightness.</li> </ol>
<b>Mac OS X</b>	<p>Choose a contrast scheme from the operating system's display settings.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. From the Apple menu select "System Preferences"</li> <li>2. From System Preferences select "Accessibility"</li> <li>3. Select the "Display" tab <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ For black text on a light background select "Use Grayscale" from the Display options.</li> <li>○ "Invert Colors" is a popular option that helps many people with visual disabilities.</li> </ul> </li> </ol>
<b>ZoomText with Mac</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Start ZoomText</li> <li>2. From the "Enhancements" menu choose the color scheme that works best for you. Screen colors will switch in real time as you make your selection.</li> </ol>
